

## Cereal Box Books

Each student will need:  
an empty cereal box  
paper to cover the box  
pencils/crayons

Students choose a chapter book on their level. After reading their book, they make their cereal box book.

1. First, students will cover their box with white paper.
2. Next they will decorate the front of the box with title, author/illustrator, and a picture for the story.
3. Then, they will find "notable quotables" from their book. They will write these on one side of the box.
4. On the other side of the box, they will write the ingredients in their story (character, setting, plot).
5. On the back of the box, they will make up a game that will teach something about the story and put it here. It can be a crossword puzzle, find a word, etc.

Optional: they can add a surprise in the cereal box.  
(examples: a gummy worm for *How To Eat Fried Worms*, a toy car for a racecar story, etc.)
