



Parts Of A Story

Title

The name of a story is called a **title**.

Author

An **author** is a person that writes a story.

Illustrator

An **illustrator** is a person that draws the pictures for a story.

Characters

The people or animals in a story are called **characters**.



Setting

The **setting** tells where the story is happening. It also tells when it is happening.



Plot

The **plot** is what the story is mostly about.



Theme

The message in the story is called the **theme**.

Author's Purpose

An author chooses one of three purposes(reasons) to write a story.

1. to entertain you
2. to inform you
3. to persuade you (try to talk you into something)

Point Of View

The narrator (person telling the story) tells what he/she thinks or feels.
